## DETAILED PROGRAM

### DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN ZAGREB

Arrival in Zagreb at ... on flight ...

You will then be greeted by your guide and driver outside the airport. Transfer to your hotel for check-in.

is located in the heart of Zagreb, opposite the main train station and close to the bus station and Zagreb Airport terminal. Not far from the hotel, just a 10-minute walk through one of Zagreb's most beautiful parks, Zrinjevac Park, you will find yourself in the city's main square and the historic city center.

*Croatia is already surprising for its strange shape. The arc that the country represents is explained by history and the very specific issues that make Croatia rich and diverse today. The country combines a long coastline with one of the largest concentrations of islands in the world, marked by the Mediterranean context and the continental Pannonian plains closely linked to the Austro-Hungarian plains. These two sets of landscapes are delimited by the Julian Alps to the north and the Dinaric ranges that descend to Greece. Whether on the coast or in the plains, the Croats have always been a people of traders benefiting from their position at the crossroads of multiple trade routes, often dating back to Antiquity and even further in the past. The city of Trogir was the site of an ancient Greek colony. The Roman heritage is best linked to the city of Split, where the city center is located within the walls of Emperor Diocletian's palace, which has been recreated throughout history to form a constantly bubbling magma of architectural styles. The tumultuous medieval past is evident in the Venetian influences on the coast with the cities of Zadar and Šibenik and the Austrian influences inland. Croatia's strategic position and wealth have aroused envy. All the joy and melancholy of the country can be found in this highly original naive art, typical of the plains, or the finesse of the sculpture of the Dalmatian stonemasons who would surpass themselves, generating true artistic revolutions such as the Radovan Portal in Trogir or the Šibenik Cathedral created by George the Dalmatian. And amidst these comings and goings, the small Republic of Dubrovnik is developing an extraordinary city-state imbued with typical art and architecture, jealously guarding its freedom with extraordinary diplomacy. Crossing Croatia means discovering a wide variety of landscapes and terroirs that are constantly changing, nurturing original, strong identities, shaped by all the influences that have marked them. This journey will transport you through the discovery of pearls of nature on the islands or in the plateaus with the Plitvice Lakes National Park... A richness that also flatters the palate because it translates into an appetizing diversity of culinary specialties. From the Mediterranean maritime scents to the gentle sounds of waterfalls... for a total pleasure of the senses!*

### DAY 2: ZAGREB

## **Breakfast at the hotel.**

After breakfast, your private guided tour of Zagreb begins. Discover its rich history, dating back to medieval times, on a guided walk..

This walk will allow you to learn about the city's rich history, which dates back to medieval times. The local guide will take you from **the main square, Ban Jelacic, to the cathedral \***, One of the city's most important monuments, you will discover the origins of the Cathedral of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, the difficulties it encountered, and its renovation..



Your route will take you to the **vibrant Tkalčićeva Street**, better known as Bar Street, where there is always a steady stream of people. You will hear about the philosophy of lazing around and other daily habits of the locals. A few steps away is the **charming funicular**.

It is the oldest form of public transport in the city and has been bringing joy to the people of Zagreb for over 125 years. **Board the boat to Gradec, the upper town.** Gradec is one of the two medieval settlements that formed Zagreb.

## **Lunch**

**Take a stroll along the charming Strossmayer Promenade**, the best place to get a panoramic view of the rooftops of Zagreb. Visit the **Lotrščak Tower and St. Mark's Church \***. The latter, with its picturesque roof, is featured on the most frequently sent postcard of Zagreb. Explore the side streets, discover their charm, and perhaps step into one of the old courtyards. Walk down to Zagreb's oldest pharmacy, dating back to the 14th century. Go through the Stone Gate as you leave the Upper Town. This gate was part of the Old Town's defense system and is the only one to survive. Inside, a small chapel houses the miraculous image of Our Lady, the patron saint of Zagreb..



Continue your tour to coastal Croatia with a stopover **to the Plitvice Lakes** and a night in Licko Petrovo Selo

Visit **the oldest national park in Croatia**. Arrive at the UNESCO World Heritage Site for a nature walk through the magnificent Upper Lakes Forests. Marvel at a system of 16 lakes separated by travertine barriers and examine this incredible natural phenomenon up close. Learn how lakes, karst rivers, and streams are an ongoing process that continues to shape the landscape over time. Admire some of the magnificent waterfalls and stand in front of them. **the great waterfall (Veliki slap)**, 78 meters high, to hear the roaring thunder of the water as it hits the ground.

**Specialty lunch in the park to break up the walk**

After Plitvice, continue to Licko Petrovo Selo (duration: 15 minutes)

Afterwards, **visit to Smiljan, the birthplace of Nikola Tesla**. (Journey time: 1 hour 10 minutes

The great inventor and physicist was born on July 10, 1856, and his birthplace has been transformed into a memorial center. It presents an interpretation of Tesla's life, as well as the village with which Tesla identified strongly, from which he left and where he

had his first ideas for his first inventions. The memorial center is the place where the great genius took the first steps towards his greatest achievements that changed the world. Tesla was born into a parish family, in a house located next to the Orthodox Church of St. Peter and St. Paul, built in 1765.

After visiting the memorial center, continue to **Šibenik with a stopover in Zadar**. (journey time: 2 hours) Zadar is both a time machine and an open-air museum. Here you will find some of the most beautiful architectural and cultural heritage monuments on the eastern Adriatic coast..

After a walk through the old town of Zadar, you will continue to Šibenik for hotel check-in.

**Free dinner** and overnight stay at the hotel in Šibenik. (journey time: 1 hour 10 minutes)

Check-in at the 3-star Amadria Park Beach Hotel Niko. The 3-star Amadria Park Beach Hotel Niko is located 6.5 km from the town of Šibenik and is part of the Amadria Park Resort. The hotel offers an airy and relaxed atmosphere, with a variety of relaxation areas: beach, poolside, or terrace. The hotel has a restaurant, terrace, beach, and Wi-Fi. There is also a water park near the hotel.

### DAY 5: SIBENIK

#### Breakfast at the hotel.

This day is reserved for **a wine tasting in Rakovo selo**, near Šibenik. Continue for a 15-minute drive to the Rak winegrowers' house in the small village of Dubrava in the Šibenik hinterland, an area known for Babić red wine, one of the best in the country. Its

vineyard forms a unique landscape where everything is done by hand! The Rak house is classified as an agritourism property. **Tasting of 3 wines.**



This region enjoys a unique microclimate influenced by the Krka River and the Adriatic Sea. Located 250 meters above sea level, it is characterized by cool nights and many warm, sunny days..

### **Free lunch**

After the wine tasting, return to **Šibenik for free time** in the old town. (Journey time 15 minutes)

Self-guided discovery. Šibenik is a picturesque Dalmatian village founded by the Croats, unlike other Dalmatian towns of ancient origin. A royal city with numerous fortresses, it is famous for its Cathedral of St. James, an unparalleled architectural feat that has earned it UNESCO World Heritage status. Šibenik is one of the only towns in Croatia with a beautiful beach close to the historic center.

## **DAY 6: SIBENIK – SALONA – KLIS – MAKARSKA**

### **Breakfast**

On the way to Makarska with stops at **Salona (journey time: 1 hour 10 minutes)** and **Klis Fortress (journey time: 15 minutes)** where a visit to the fortress is planned.

**The old Salona** is located in the heart of Solin and was once the capital of the Roman province of Dalmatia. It is the largest archaeological park in Croatia, whose size is evidenced by the monumental walls with towers and gates, a forum with temples, an amphitheater, and cemeteries with Salonian martyrs (Manastirine, Kapljuč, Marusinac). Salona was a city of over 60,000 inhabitants and, according to legend, the birthplace of Emperor Diocletian..

After Salona, **Klis Fortress** is the next place you will visit on the itinerary. Klis Fortress (Tvrđava Klis) has a history of over 2,000 years, beginning with the Illyrian tribe called Dalmatae who used it as a stronghold before it was captured by the Romans. After the fall of the Roman Empire, the site became the seat of several Croatian kings.

It abolished slavery as early as the 15th century, its hygiene measures prevented major epidemics, its facades are all identical to avoid social unrest... so many astonishing measures of this avant-garde system in history. The scale of its trade can be read in every stone of this city, which is among the best-preserved medieval towns in the world. "The Pearl of the Adriatic," listed by UNESCO, is a tourist hotspot in Croatia and will surprise you with its beauty and exceptional culture at the crossroads between Europe, the Mediterranean, and the Middle East. We recommend visiting the Rector's Palace, the Franciscan monasteries for its old pharmacy and the Dominican monasteries for their collection of typical Dubrovnik paintings, not to mention its imposing ramparts.!*

Located close to monuments such as the Chiesa del Santissimo Sacramento (1.3 km) and the Santuario di San Benedetto (1.4 km), the Hotel Masaniello Luxury is perfectly located for exploring Casoria's various attractions.

\*(Self-guided itinerary idea: You will explore the famous Spaccanapoli, its churches, its mansions, the picturesque streets of the santoniers, and finally visit the magnificent cloister of Santa Chiara, whose basilica is the largest Gothic monument in the city. Departure for a tour of the historic center of Naples. You will discover the Piazza del Plebiscito, located in the heart of the city, bordered by the Royal Palace, the Palazzo Salerno, and the Palazzo della Prefettura.

Continue to the Galleria Umberto I, then admire the Castel Nuovo.

Before exploring Via Toledo and its typical and popular shops, you will finish Visit the exterior of the Egg Castle, the oldest castle.

If you have time, Parrocchia San Mauro (0.6 mi), Chiesa Santa Maria delle Grazie (0.9 mi), and CAM Casoria Contemporary Art Museum (1.1 mi) are popular attractions located within walking distance..

## DAY 12: PALERMO

**Palermo** is the cultural jewel of Sicily. The monumental center, in the middle of streets that hesitate between opulent buildings and houses lined with scaffolding, it brings together most of the monuments from before the Risorgimento: the imposing cathedral dedicated to **Our Lady of the Assumption**, the **Norman Palace**, ancient Punic, Roman and Byzantine fortress currently seat of the Parliament of the region of Sicily, the **Piazza Pretoria** with his **superb fountain once nicknamed "fountain of shame" because of its nude statues**.

### Lunch

Guided tour of Piazza Armerina with Villa Romana del Casale. You can admire the suggestive ruins of the Roman villa, known throughout the world for its splendid floor mosaics; scholars have put forward different hypotheses on the dating (between the 3rd and mid-4th centuries AD) and the identification of the owner, probably a military man close to the imperial court. In 1161 a flood caused a landslide that buried the villa; it was therefore restructured and excavations are still in progress. The mosaics, the thermal area and the large peristyle are of particular interest..


